Hopton Castle Parish Meeting 22 January 2019 – Finance Report

- I have attached a summary of our bank account together with a detailed breakdown
 of income and spending relating to the defibrillator. You can see that there is a
 balance of £391.31 raised through our village fundraising events and the successful
 Big Lottery Grant.
- 2. Our agreement with the Community Heartbeat Trust includes us making an annual support payment, which this year is £162 (£132 plus VAT). We have also agreed to put money aside each year (£165) for 10 years as a replacement fund for the future since the defib has a 10 year life span. In addition there is a commitment to hold an annual awareness session for Hopton Castle and Bedstone residents, £175 shared between our two villages.
- 3. This gives us an annual requirement of £414.50.
- 4. While this sum can be covered by current balances this year, the Parish Meeting has previously agreed to raise a precept of £15 per household, to ensure we have the funds we need for the next few years. The precept should raise £706, based on the calculations of numbers of households provided by Shropshire County Council.
- 5. Our application to raise a precept must be submitted to Shropshire by 31 January, so the meeting is requested to reaffirm their decision to raise a precept of £15 per household for the financial year 2019/20.
