

**NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF PUBLIC PATH EXTINGUISHMENT AND  
DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER**

**HIGHWAYS ACT 1980  
WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981**

**THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL (FOOTPATH 11, PARISH OF HOPTON CASTLE) PUBLIC  
PATH EXTINGUISHMENT ORDER 2018**

On 18th January 2019, The Shropshire Council (the "Council") confirmed the above named order made under section 118 of the Highways Act 1980 and section 53A(2) of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981. The effect of the order as confirmed is to **extinguish**

the full width of Footpath 11 Hopton Castle, from point A on the Order Map (SO 3409 7686), running in a general north-north-easterly direction along a woodland path to a junction with Footpath 5 at point E on the Order Map (SO 3415 7719); a total distance of approximately 340 metres.

A copy of the order as confirmed and the order map have been placed and may be seen free of charge at The Shirehall, Abbey Foregate, Shrewsbury during normal office hours or via the Council's website at

Shropshire Council certify that the order becomes operative on 18th January 2019; but if a person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the order, he or she may, under paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 18th January 2019 make an application to the High Court.
